February 10, 2026

Bob Kish reported that he was working of revisions to the 1977 Street Cut Ordinance. He submitted a 7 item list of what he had completed but stated that it would be a lengthy process.

Mayor Schaa reviewed the Police Report with council.

The Administrator notified council that the McGill, Power and Bell accountants are in the office auditing the government activities for all of the funds. They use this information to prepare an audited financial statement and submit to the PA DCED.
