

MERCER BOROUGH WORK SESSION

February 3, 2026

Nick Sicilian led the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance and announced that County Commissioner Bill Finley was in attendance as a visitor. Commissioner Finley commented that he, Commissioner Coleman and Commissioner McGonagle wished to express their gratitude for the coordination and efforts of Mercer Borough to clear the accumulation of snow from the town square and intersections. He added that the joint cooperation between PAdot, the Borough, the contractor and the County was exceptional and appreciated. Cliff Hughes asked if the County could contribute funds to the Borough as they did in the past in lieu of taxes. Commissioner Finley agreed to look into it.

Savannah Bungar informed council that she believed there should be a procedure in place for situations similar to this commenting that the Borough should have scheduled a Special Meeting to approve the work that costs \$ 1,250.00. Bob Perrine and Marc Zickar agreed. Nick Sicilian asked the Street Committee to work on a procedure that could be utilized in the future.

Savannah Bungar informed council that she was reviewing the Sewer Billing Procedures and Delinquent accounts. The Administrator explained the process that was currently being used and invited her to come into the business office for further explanations of the procedures currently in place.

Bob Perrine stated that he was reviewing the 1977 Street cut and repair ordinance commenting that he believed it needed amended. Council discussed utility work currently being performed in the Borough.

Council reviewed the letter from GFT outlining the Liquid Damages that would be paid by the Sewer Improvement Project Contractors if the project is not completed on time. The Administrator agreed to notify GFT that they agreed with the computations.

Council discussed repairs to the Dump Truck and also discussed replacing the vehicle if needed. The meeting was properly adjourned.
