

MERCER BOROUGH SPECIAL MEETING

June 3rd, 2025

Nick Sicilian moved to open the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Cliff Hughes moved to hire Jeff Staul, Staul's Water Technology as a sub-contractor part-time to perform the weekend sewer plant work approximately every third weekend. Joe Burns seconded the motion. Vote carried unanimously. Council set the hourly rate at \$ 50.00 an hour.

The meeting was properly adjourned.

WORK SESSION

Nick Sicilian called the Work Session to order. Nick Sicilian stated the catch basins on N. Pitt Street will be temporary plated to divert the water from collection pipe that runs through 450 N. Pitt Street.

Council discussed the use of a new generator to supply power to the traffic signal at the Y intersection and decided portable stop signs would be better.

Council discussed remedies for the intersection of Turkey Street at W. Venango Street where the pot holes are forming in the cartway and right of way areas.

The Administrator announced that council would not be considering the open council position at this meeting.

Council discussed procedures for obtaining the employees planned vacation schedules. Savannah Bungar discussed requiring council and employees to have their own email accounts set up by the Borough instead of using their personal accounts.

Cliff Hughes stated that there have been many accidents at the intersection of E. Butler Street and S. Pitt and council should do something to help the situation. Nick Sicilian recommended having lights on the stop signs to begin with.

The meeting was adjourned to an Executive Session to discuss a personnel issue. The meeting was called back to order and properly adjourned.
