Aaron Sines led the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Cliff Hughes moved to approve the April 8<sup>th</sup> and May 6<sup>th</sup> Minutes with Marc Zickar seconding. Vote carried unanimously. Nick Sicilian moved to approve the Treasurers Report with Cliff Hughes seconding. Vote carried unanimously. Nick Sicilian moved to approve the Payment of Bills with Cliff Hughes seconding.
